CLÁUDIO RICHERME, Pianist

Pianist CLÁUDIO RICHERME was born in São João da Boa Vista, São Paulo, Brazil, where he started his piano studies. When he was fifteen, in 1968, he won the Competition of the State Council of Culture and received from La Jeunesse Musicale of São Paulo the "Prize Guiomar Novaes" awarded to the youngest artist with exceptional qualities. Since then, he has been twice awarded the prize of the São Paulo Association of Art Critics as the "Best Recitalist of the Year". He graduated from the São Paulo Music College under Professor J.S. Benda, and had lessons with Guiomar Novaes, who still coaches him.

By invitation of the "Partners of the Americas", Mr. Richerme came to Chicago for six months and was "Artist in Residence" of the American Conservatory of Music. During this time, he gave a series of recitals, classes and lectures on Brazilian music. In an American tour, he has appeared in concert with the Lake Shore Orchestra. This appearance marks Mr. Richerme's New York recital debut.
